#### Food & Supplies Needed for Local Families

In addition to the food that goes to local food pantries, Christ Church serves local families in need. The following items are needed: **cleaning supplies, paper towels, toilet paper, personal hygiene products, deodorant, and soap.** The Tiger's Den is collecting **condiments (ketchup, mustard, mayo, syrup), flour,** 

sugar, oil, and salt during the summer. They also request paper bags and reusableshopping bags (*NOT plastic bags*) to pack groceries.
