Another Cup of Coffee

There are maybe only a couple of occasions a year when I get the opportunity to connect with my brother and his family. Even rarer are those times when we host. This past Sunday, following a brief visit to my parents, they joined us for an overnight before school and jobs demanded their return home the following day.

What this means practically for my niece and nephew and even my brother and sister-inlaw is an initial few hours cast with a certain patina of social awkwardness. The litany of common questions concerning work, family, and home is exhausted with often, because of both the infrequency and briefness of these moments, our conversations never managing to venture beyond the common. But no one seemed rushed to leave on Monday, all of us enjoying another cup of coffee and more time before finally the endless march of the clock demanded action.

Until then, for well over two hours we casually chatted about nothing in particular with no inclination or motivation to end our time together.

Jesus talked about being present with us when 2 or 3 are gathered, which I believe generally a truth no matter setting or situation. There are moments, however, such as what I experienced on Monday that gathered by love and in our



connection to one another God ends up encouraging us to just remain in that holy space. When it happens, mutter a little thanksgiving to God, put on another pot of coffee, and linger for just a little longer ... -Pastor Daven

Food & Supplies Needed for Local Families
