A Word From Pastor Daven

The Last Lecture

The central focus of worship over these past three weeks has been Paul's second letter to Timothy. This Sunday marks the final chapter and installment. These words were Paul's last to his protege, likely the last words we have of Paul before his death. It's got me thinking a lot about final words ...

It's become a phenomenon of sorts with the book <u>The Last Lecture</u>, based on, as the title implies, the last lecture by Randy Pausch given at Carnegie Mellon after a diagnosis of terminal pancreatic cancer a year prior. But we can look back at Paul and see the same. In essence, these final talks seek to share insights, wisdom, encouragement, and hope knowing it was likely the last chance to do so.

Being a Christian means living at that very edge all the time. As scripture says, "Keep watch, because you do not know the day or the hour of my return." Our lives should be ones that are an ongoing last lecture. The way we live, who we are, what we say, what we do, and the choices we make all have the power to communicate the insights, wisdom, encouragement, and hope of our faith to others.


