I may yet return to the snowflake, each a distinct individual and the amassing of them leading to a blanket which covers the ground, offering a fresh perspective and a sense of new beginnings. It seems such a parallel to baptism with each unique yet also connecting us to the great witnesses of faith through the generations. Instead, however, I remembered words from one of my favorite authors and felt them most appropriate for this day.

Hal Borland wrote the following in Countryman: A Summary of Belief published in 1965...

"When I write about trees and birds and the view from a hilltop, I wonder if they are important in the face of the elections, and foreign aid, and taxes, and missiles and satellites. Then I know that arguments end, men die, and nations rise and fall, but that so long as there is an earth and procession of the seasons there will be trees and birds and vistas from hilltops. And, unless we are all incredibly stupid and recklessly wicked, there will be men here to see these things ... and to feel, if never wholly to understand, what they signify."

-Maintain social distancing (6 feet apart) from those not within your immediate family.

-Please do not enter the building if you are experiencing any symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, chills, diarrhea).


