A word from Pastor Darryl

This past Sunday we have started a five-week Sermon Series "Miracles and Multitudes" using the common lectionary readings on the Gospel of John chapter 6. As Jesus lives out his life and ministry among the multitudes following him and gathering around him he extends an offering of life-giving bread! On Sunday our sub-theme was "Sharing Lunch. As we reflected together on the Scriptural reading of John 6:1-21 three things came to my mind: (1) we are called to be aware of what we have and to thank God always. (2) In the 'kin-dom' good things happen when we share our lunch. (3) We are wise to listen to children (like the boy who shared his five loaves and two fish; and like the nameless and homeless street kid who shared a piece of bread with three other street kids given to him by a pastor who was caught unexpectedly by this kid's gesture and generosity). **Good things happen** when you share your lunch! The Holy Scriptures have important things to say to us and to teach us! So often in our lives we only focus on what is absent, not on what is present. We can easily lose the 'kin-dom' perspective that out of scarcity, God shows us abundance. Out of doubt, comes faith. In

God's abundance and love, God continues to pour into all of creation that which is needed by the world. God does this through the talents, abilities and passions of many diverse individuals. Thus, it is only together that we as Christians can be God's hands, feet and voices as God's mission becomes ours when we use our time and talents; and the financial resources we produce by stewarding our God-given gifts and time to care for other human beings as we share the gospel of Jesus Christ in faith and action. So here are some questions to ponder this week:

Where in our lives have we felt like we didn't have the gifts to do what God was calling us to do, but were surprised by the outcome?

Where in our lives have we seen abundance out of what first seemed as scarcity?

Where is God calling Christ UMC today to provide a voice of abundant hope in the midst of what seems like abundant scarcity and abundant fear?

The one who feeds us sends us, and meets us on the way. **Share your lunch today! Good things happen always!** I am praying for you and with you daily. May God's love and blessings be always with you, and my love to all of you.
