A Word From Pastor Daven

Holy Conspiracy

On Sunday as we explored the final part of the series on the Holy Spirit, the word of the day was Spirit as breath. In that sermon I shared that the word 'conspire', with all its sinister connotation, literally means to 'breathe with.' And that in receiving the gift of Spirit we breathe with God, we join a holy conspiracy in that we conspire with God in our lives and with our lives.

But what is this conspiracy? Quite simply the redemption of the world. When we hear John the Baptist declare that one is coming that will baptize us with fire and the Spirit (breath) or Jesus declaring that he has come not to condemn the world, but to save it; when we pray as Jesus taught "thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" and asked to love one another as Christ loves us; when we start saying, doing, thinking, sharing, loving, hoping in these ways we join this conspiracy.

This is a conspiracy of goodness, a conspiracy of grace, a conspiracy of re-creation, a conspiracy of redemption - to breathe with God. How it is is not how it has to be or how it can be. That's a conspiracy I am happy to be connected to and associated with.
