We headed out, capitalizing on the warm day to fetch some cider from our favorite cider mill. Along the way we saw a field either barren now of their crops or in the process of being harvested. I kept a watchful eye in the hopes of seeing a combine moving through the corn so that I might stop and observe for a bit.

Although it was clear that there was a fury of harvest activity happening, the closest we got was a combine emptying its tank into an awaiting wagon. While it didn't satisfy my desire to watch machinery at work, passing all the freshly harvested fields feels more familiar. More often than not, in so many different ways we see only the results and not the process. We know that there is so much that happens before, leading to ... but we only see or enjoy the conclusion.



Faith would be simpler, perhaps, if it was the same - where we could just see the results. Instead faith is all about the work and the process. It is out in the fields of our existence where we operate the machinery of aligning the holiness of our hearts with the holiness of our lives. It is a seemingly endless season in steps, setbacks, activities, and growth. So pause and ponder the next time you are near an empty field. The result of a life of faith will come ... in the meantime the work calls!

Thirstaid Thursdays


Thirstaid Thursday will also follow along with the all-church read. All are invited to join a Zoom study Thursdays at 1pm for the next three weeks.
