A Word From Pastor Daven

Leaves

At some point in life we begin to see things that once caused great joy as a burden. This past weekend I spent Sunday afternoon helping my parents with leaves, only on Monday to spend the majority of the day managing my own. If I ever see a leaf again ...!

Yet through the eyes of my daughter the leaves that fall along the winds of seasonal change are an opportunity. Raking them into a pile becomes a possibility. And with one leap there evokes laughter and joy in the jumping. When do we lose that fun, the simple pleasure of the crunch of leaves under our feet? I know we could chalk it up to responsibility, complicated schedules with limited time, and to being a chore rather than play. Those are all very true. But we have something to learn and be reminded of in our children - perhaps a good reason that Christ said "let the little children come unto me" (Matt 19:14) as we come to see the beauty of God's creation through their eyes.
