Thank you to all who have responded with a commitment, helping us to achieve our ambitions as a faith community to "make connections and offer opportunities for faith, love, and service." We are close to our goal to meeting our ministry objectives now, some 10+ pledges short of the current year totaling \$20,000 ministry dollars. NYS has created a color-coded system to indicate levels of COVID-19 with limitations imposed based upon color. Currently our region is in a 'yellow zone' which has no impact on our current gathering with already enacted policies including mandatory masks and physical distancing. If our region moves into an 'orange zone', our in-person gatherings for worship will be limited beyond those directly involved to 20 people. In the event that we do move into this, we are inviting those interested in attending in-person to call the church office (839-2460) on the Friday directly prior to each Sunday between 10am - 2pm with those 20 spots being reserved on a first-come-first-served basis.

If our region moves into a 'red zone', all in-person worship will be suspended. We continue to offer online worship opportunities via Live Stream on our YouTube channel, which is archived following its conclusion. While our hope remains to have in-person opportunities for Sunday worship, Music & Meditation on Friday evenings (beginning next Friday, November 27), and on Christmas Eve, we are committed to the health and safety of all people. We will follow all guidelines provided and strongly advise any who are nervous or feeling even slightly unwell to please stay home and worship virtually through this time.
