Next Steps in the Journey...

Christ UMC's journey toward the future has started. With energy and enthusiasm, the 42 planning retreat participants shared their hopes, dreams and prayers for the life and ministry of Christ UMC for the future ministries of the church. The results of the retreat included a series of possible purpose statements based on the morning's group discussions. What happens next?

A planning team has been formed which will meet on Sat., Nov. 5 to develop a draft of a purpose statement based on the results of the retreat. Members of the planning team are: Guy Castellino (Team Leader), Peggy Bermudez, John Miller, Dave Lawson, Lee Watson, Michelle Cordero, Pam Lopez, Chris Smith, Sally Pollard, Jim Pollard. The team will organize at least 7 small group gatherings between Nov. 6 and Thanksgiving in which the drafted purpose statement will be presented for discussion and response by participants. Dates and locations will be posted at the church and circulated by mail and e-mail so members and friends can indicate the gathering they will attend. The group meetings will be led by members of the planning team.

The purpose statement will then be revised, and will serve as the basis for the development of proposed strategies for accomplishing the purpose. Throughout the process, our consultant, Rev. John Wimberly, Jr. will serve as a resource and guide to the Planning Team. Each step will have opportunities for participation by members and participants in the congregation.

At a date still to be determined, Rev. Wimberly will return to lead a retreat day to guide completion of the strategic plan, which then will be presented to the Church Council and the congregation for approval.

If you were not at the retreat, the group meetings will be opportunities for you to participate in the process. Watch for the schedule, and be sure to sign up. The more people who participate, the stronger the plan will be.

Throughout, please spend time in prayer for God's guidance and the leading of the Holy Spirit throughout this journey.
