It was yet another example on different occasion when the nature of these times through which we are living called for creative adaptation. We got dressed up as a family, delivered treats to the patios of some friends, and made a special Halloween supper in our own efforts. Elsewhere I saw elaborate yard displays, numerous outdoor fires, tables setup at the end of driveways, and countless other approaches.

I understand that we've all grown a bit wearied of continually having to adjust and adapt. Yet as follower of Jesus, this is simply a part of who we are as a people. 
