## **Perspective**

Fewer and fewer of these relics of the past remain. At one time these were the primary means to observing and responding to danger, primarily fire, with people fulfilling the role of watching throughout the day and night. Now they have been cordoned off to prevent climbing on them, converted to bird or scenic observation points, or allowed to collapse and deteriorate.

We went to get a look at the fall color while listening and viewing migratory waterfowl. Climbing the rickety steps, I thought of the many who had ascended them in the past, taken their station at the top, and provided a vital public service. I whispered a word of thanks that this tower still stood, granting us this opportunity, and for all those who had spent cold nights looking out for this area.



Then, I thought of the saints of the church. These individuals who climbed the steps of faith in lives dedicated to applying what they believed. I thought of those ways that they looked out for danger and the fires which could tear communities apart, doing their best to spot and extinguish them. I thought about my gratitude that I still had this same tower to climb in my life, the same perspective that I could gain in ascending those steps, the same opportunity to observe and know the truth of God's love in Christ. I whispered a quiet word of thanks for faith, for those before me who applied that faith seeking safety and peace for all, and for the opportunity to gaze upon and gain perspective. The means may have changed, but the mission and ministry remains. It is now up to us to take upon the mantle of the saints of the past in living and applying our faith for the salvation of the world.


## All-Church Read: The Gospel According to Leviticus


