Creation Care

I've seen the scene many times leaving church on Sunday morning, Mongo plodding along next to Scott following worship. It has always brought a smile to my face, but on this occasion it touched me more deeply.

In the creation narratives of Genesis, a key feature is the responsibility and relationship that we have with and to creation. Maybe my pause in the scene of Mongo & Scott is that sense of connection and care. Unfortunately human beings often place themselves as the pinnacle of creation. From this position, we have used and abused nature, bending and distorting it to our benefits and desired outcomes. We have been irrespective to the damage to other beings and environment and irreverent to God's creation.



When Jesus teaches in parable that "when you did it to one of the least of these, you were doing it to me" (Matt. 25:40) perhaps we have too narrowly defined this as interactions simply between each other / fellow human beings. Heaven knows we have a long way to go even in that regard. But as long as we limit it in this way, we limit the true possibility of earth reflecting heaven and peace prevailing. The prophets speak of such a time; may we help to usher it in one relationship at a time.


Fund for Dave Wolf
