In addition to the food that goes to local food pantries, Christ Church serves local families in need. The following items are needed: cleaning supplies, paper towels, toilet paper, personal hygiene products, deodorant, and soap.

The Tiger's Den is collecting cooking supplies (flour, sugar, oil, and salt) and healthy snacks (crackers, granola bars) during the summer. They also request paper bags and reusable shopping bags (NOT plastic bags) to pack groceries.
