This opportunity is offered every **Thursday** from **1 – 2:30 p.m.** in the Wesley Room. All are welcome to come for a weekly serving of "Thirstaid" to satisfy our spirits as we explore a variety of themes with different facilitators. First up: Diane Klenk will guide "Bad Girls of the Bible" through October 4. With humor and candor, we'll take a look at what we can learn from the lives of these women.

The Wesley Challenge! (Date Changes!)

Between November 4 and November 25 – you are invited to engage with others, using a resource titled "The Wesley Challenge: 21 Days to a More Authentic Faith," using questions asked by John Wesley to his students and friends at Oxford University.

On Sundays, Nov. 11, 18 & 25, Pastor Daven Oskvig's sermons will explore three themes of the questions:

- Relationship With God: an Upward Focus
- Relationship with Self: an Inward Focus
- Relationship with Others: an Outward Focus

The Spiritual Formation Team invites adults and youth to participate in "The Wesley Challenge" by reading the book daily beginning November 4 (one question for each day), attending worship each Sunday, and joining with others in group reflection and conversation during the three-week period.
