Heart Envelope

Supplies: red or pink cardstock / heavy construction paper, Bible, scissors, colored pencils, markers, stickers, template (printed from computer)



When we're down, we can always count on God to listen to us. Tell God what is on your mind...... We can always call to God and he'll wrap us in his love like a warm blanket. How can you help someone else that needs God to listen?

Read Psalm 86:6-7 Fold the left side of the heart inward on the fold line.

Psalm 86:6-7 New International Version

6 Hear my prayer, Lord; listen to my cry for mercy.

7 When I am in distress, I call to you, because you answer me.

Read Psalm 86:11-13 Fold the fight side of the heart inward on th fold line.

Psalm 86:11-13 New International Version **11** Teach me your way, Lord,

that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

- 12 I will praise you, Lord my God, with all my heart; I will glorify your name forever.
- **13** For great is your love toward me; you have delivered me from the depths. from the realm of the dead.

Read Psalm 86:1-5 Fold the top of the heart inward on the fold line.

Psalm 86:1-5 New International Version

- 1 Hear me, Lord, and answer me, for I am poor and needy.
- 2 Guard my life, for I am faithful to you; save your servant who trusts in you. You are my God; 3 have mercy on me, Lord, for I call to you all day long.
- 4 Bring joy to your servant, Lord, for I put my trust in you.
- 5 You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to you.

Fold the bottom part of the heart inward to complete the envelope.

Add color and pattern to the inside surface with markers, colored pencils, etc! Cut out one of the Bible verses to place inside the heart envlope. Add a special message for someone you care about. Attach a sticker to hold the folds closed.

Write the address on the outside of the envelope and add the stamp!
